- 1. Minutes of the meeting of December 15, 2014 were accepted as corrected.
- 2. The ABPP Workshop will be held at Helen Silverman's apartment on Saturday morning February 7th, or March 7th. - 6. A question arose as to whether the Society is allowed to make charitable donations to other organizations and we will research this.
- 7. An election committee of three has been formed, it comprised of one officer, and two members of the Board. Maureen, Harriette and Ella respectively...... will serve as chair of the election committee. Sharon will serve as Corresponding Secretary of the Board. Psych Society. Members can nominate themselves for Board membership. The call for nominations will go out on February 1st. Nominations must be submitted within 30 days. The election process will be completed 90 days after the initial request for nominations.

Newly elected Board members will be invited to attend the June 15th dinner. Board Officers will serve two-year terms. The president and vice-president may not serve

successive terms. Ella will not serve on the Board after this semester as she will be filling another pro-bono position, starting in June, that of grandmother.
