

Invites you to attend its Ninth Biennial Conference at New York University



At the end of the first psychoanalytic century, are psychoanalysts still interested in sexuality at all? Have we come to see sexuality only as a metaphor for relationships? Or are we focused on sexually perverse practices where the capacity for metaphor has collapsed? And how does desire relate to gender? Is sexuality determined by gender, or are they loosely coupled variables? This conference offers an array of recent clinical investigations of problematic sexuality, from transgressive boundary violations to theoretical boundary expansion. Topics include: sexual violence and the internal object world of perpetrators; girls' anxieties and pleasure; gender as an issue or non-issue in gay and lesbian parenting; complex erotic counter-transference; and cultural/ethnic influences on sexuality. A group of wide-ranging papers on sexual identity include an example of the inability to mourn in cross-dressing and a critique of the "myth" of a lesbian identity. Conference members are invited to participate in discussing these latest encounters between psychoanalysis and sexuality.


