- 1. Helen opened meeting with acceptance of previous minute from 10/1210 with 2 additions.
- 2. Helen reported that Bob had sent the memorial memo to tracks and only 2 new names were added. Irving Steingart and Larry Gould. He will let Shelley know so that they can be included on memorial list.
- 3. Discussion of next years Memorial lecture was postponed until Maureen was at meeting and could tell us more about what is being planned.
- 4. We need a Rep for senate and Harriette almost volunteered. It was voted that the Society would pay cab fare for the Rep. Harriett will let us know her final decision soon.
- 5. Date for the Cocktail party will be on February 25 6-9 at Harmonie club. Sharonn reported that they have raised their fee to \$95 per person. There was discussion about finding another place to have cocktail party in 2012, perhaps at a restaurant.

The fee structure was changed for the cocktail party with members paying 35. And guests paying 50. Passed by 6 to 1.
