- 1. Cover sheet listing ONLY your name, address, phone number, email address, title of proposal, and whether you are a current Society member or current Postdoc candidate. Please include this information for all applicants if the application is for a Group grant (All Group applicants must be current Society members.)
- 2. Please submit the following information <u>without</u> any of the above identifying data so that the proposals can be reviewed anonymously.

a) Title of project (be sure this matches exactly the title on cover sheet)

b) Indicate whether you are applying for **Individual** (\$1,500), **Group** (\$2,000) or **Patrick Lane** (Candidate) (\$1,000) Grant

c) Names of People/organizations involved (excluding names of applicants)

d) Abstract of 400-500 words describing in detail your proposed project. Be specific with regard to all of the following (when applicable):

goals of the project

specific content, methodology and measures, when relevant

steps required for completion

anticipated time frame for completion

relevance of project to psychoanalysis

 form of presentation to professional or public audiences (Note: The Psychoanalytic Society must be credited as a funding source in all forms of presentation.)

e) If you have done previous work in this area (published or unpublished), please describe

f) If you wish, list up to three bibliographic references pertinent to your project
